Membership Criteria

Private document – for interviewers only. Not for general PMA membership

September 2025

These guidelines are a summary of an internal document approved by the RTTL Board of Trustees, defining our exclusive membership criteria. This should help RTTL interviewers make their recommendations to the board on the qualifications of an applicant.

Supreme Court case law suggests that we, as a truly private club, should have a list of exclusive membership criteria, and that we should apply it as consistently as possible, and that we should have a substantial record of rejections.

General Criteria for RTTL Membership
<i>Only people of Aryan ancestry with traditional social, political, and religious beliefs, of stable mind and moral character.</i>

Acceptable Methods of Determining Ancestry		
Physical appearance and behavior	Family genealogy	DNA test
<p><i>If there are any questions as to whether an individual is sufficiently Aryan, the Board will assess this on a case-by-case basis. This approach is taken at Orania, a community that only accepts Dutch Afrikaaners.</i></p>		

List of Inclusionary Criteria
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Strong nuclear and extended family. 2. One man married to one woman. 3. Traditional gender roles. 4. Homeschooling and other alternatives to the now-corrupted public school systems. 5. God / Logos / the Divine (whatever name they may give it) 6. Any ancient Aryan/European religion that does not have a moral code that contradicts with our traditional values. (Most commonly you'll see Christianity and then Asatru (Norse Pagan) with a smattering of other things) 7. The applicant must be of either of the two genders (male or female) and must not subscribe to alternative modern gender theories. 8. The applicant must be sane and of sound mind. 9. The applicant must have a relatively clean criminal record. Any crimes must have been fairly minor, explainable, and well in the past.

“Individuals, couples, or families with one or more individuals who possess a noticeable portion of genetics that are not of Aryan ancestry, or who would otherwise fail our ancestry-related membership criteria”		
“Individuals who do not maintain a compliant family ancestry, whether through marriage, adoption, or procreation”		
<p>Those who can be described as wholly “non-white” or conclusively “mixed race,” or those who have partners, spouses, or immediate family members who can be described as such.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Exemption: Parents with disqualified children that do not have legal custody and are permanently estranged from their non-white partner/children may be granted an exception by the Board on a case-by-case basis. 		

Actual Ancestry - What are we looking for?

We generally don't want:

- Anyone more than 1/16 African. *“Admixture of less than that percentage is not possible to accurately discern from modern DNA tests so the board shall not concern itself with such a determination.”*

We *might be okay with*, on a case-by-case basis:

- Individuals with 1/8 or less admixture from an ethnic group that itself can contain a significant portion of Aryan admixture, may be admitted on a case-by-case basis depending on their appearance, DNA test, family genealogy, or other factors as determined by the Board.

Anything more specific:

Leave it to the board to decide.

Red Flags:

These items are not strict exclusionary criteria, but they may add to an overall case of rejecting an applicant or expelling an existing member, depending on how they are manifested:

- Not denouncing Jewry or not identifying Jews as one of the biggest problems facing Aryans
- Sovereign Citizens / State Nationals: They can sometimes pose a legal risk to RTTL depending on how much activism and proselytizing they do.
- Vegans, potheads, hippies
- RTTL's official religious policy is that of Positive Aryan Theology. Therefore,
 - Adam Green fans / Propertarians / Natural Law Institute / Curt Doolittle enthusiasts: We have many of these people in the PMA and generally they are great guys. Occasionally however they may feel that religious infighting is their duty, or they may get pushy with the NLI

philosophy as a utopic ideal. The average Adam Green zoomer, back when we had the religious chat groups, would often start arguments trying to debunk Christianity with terms like “Abrahamic desert cult,” “slave morality,” and “pacifism.”

- Anti-Pagans: In the same vein, watch out for Christians who will constantly try to fight with Pagans and “debunk” their religions, calling them gay or idolatrous.
- Circumcision, Hebrew Roots, Sacred Name, etc. Let’s try to keep Talmudic Jewish influence out of the PMA please. *“those sects, while they claim to be Christian, actually tend to place elements of modern Talmudic Judaism in place of or in addition to Christian rites and rituals, which could be seen as contrary to RTTL’s policy of Positive Aryan Theology.”*
